Payment Policy

At SkyStone we aim to keep our tuition prices reasonable for all of our families. It has always been our tradition and policy to provide family rates/discounted rates into the fee schedule. Once you take a core class (see further descriptions on the Tuition Information page) your next core class whether it be for a sibling or multiple classes per week, is always significantly discounted.

Tuition payments are made monthly. There is no deduction for missed classes. We encourage the student to attend another class to make up the absence. Occasionally the calendar will fall in such a way as to include 5 classes in a month. We do not charge additional fees when there is a month with 5 weeks of classes.

Tuition payments are due within the first 10 days of the month. Families that prefer to pay tuition after the 10th of the month may do so for a \$10 fee.

Payments can be made in the form of cash, check, or automatic withdrawal. Credit card payments can be made through Pay-Pal with a \$5 transaction fee.

If the student wishes to drop a/the class at any time throughout the year, we kindly ask for 30 days notification to make the adjustment to your monthly statement.
